



Welcome To Your Rental Boat!!!

There are a few rules that must be adhered to in order to have a trouble free rental. We ask that you read these rules and abide by them at all times. Any abuse of these rules could cause serious or very expensive problems.

RENTAL BOAT GUIDELINES

1. Always be aware of where your passengers are. Do not have anyone hanging off of the side of, or hanging off of the back of the boat while the boat is in operation. Do not have anyone on the top of the boat (if it is a boat with a top) at any time. Remember you are responsible.
2. **VERY IMPORTANT** - All of these boats are water-cooled. They should have a small stream of water coming out of each engine. If for some reason there is not a strong water stream coming out of the engine, shut the engine down immediately and call the marina at **865-397-7997** or **865-603-0769**. This would very likely mean that engine damage is a possibility and you will be held liable for that damage.
3. **VERY IMPORTANT** - Each engine must also have the proper amount of oil to run without locking up the engine. Each operator must mix or add the oil properly (unless it is a 4-stroke) or the engine could be ruined.
4. These engines should all have an alarm that sounds if there is a problem with the engine. Should you hear the alarm, shut the engine down immediately and call the marina.
5. These boats must be operated in the proper depth of water. Just because you are in the middle of the lake does not mean the water is deep enough to operate the boat there. See your marina personnel to explain the channel markers. All boats must operate inside the channel markers when operation at full speed. If for some reason you are operating outside of the channel markers, you must operate at idle speed only. The risk of not abiding by the #5 rule is that a propeller or even a lower unit on the engine could be ruined (cost of up to \$2000.00).
6. Boats shall not for any reason be driven onto the shoreline for loading or unloading. Boats may only be tied up to a permanent or floating dock.
7. When exiting and entering your rental boat be cautious of possible mud or dirt on your shoes. If boat is returned in an unsuitable or dirty manner you will be charged for the cleaning of the boat at \$45 per hour.
